Marla Eva Moser

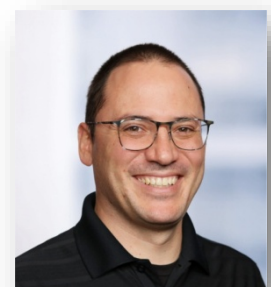
